### 2016-2017 Influenza Vaccine Information

The Wells-Ogunquit School District will be holding influenza vaccine clinics at each school during the school day. Although the vaccine will be available at no cost to every student, providing the information for insurance billing (if applicable) on the permission form covers the cost of supplies associated with the influenza clinics.

Specific date information will be coming from the school. WHS students may see the school nurse during the school day for a vaccination.

- ✓ **Reminder:** Some children less than 9 years of age may need 2 doses of flu vaccine this year.
- ✓ Please see the Dosage Information Sheet for Parents to determine if your child will need 2 doses.
- ✓ **Nasal Vaccine is not recommended for the 2016-2017 influenza season therefore only injectable vaccine is available this year. Nasal vaccine cannot be offered.**
