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Freshman – Class of 2014 Materials for School Year 2010 - 2011:

June 2010. Check the 9th grade team website at froshteam.org for information pertaining to freshman courses.

The following are required daily in the freshman core subjects and are needed on the first day:

- **Notebooks** (one per subject: see froshteam.org, teacher pages for specific requirements.)
- **#2 pencils** (mechanical pencils are acceptable)
- **Blue or Black Pens**
- **USB flash/memory drive - at least 128 MB (see below)**
- See teacher pages on the froshteam.org for more specifics

The following are required on an as needed basis in the freshman core subjects:

- Graphing Calculator – Texas Instruments: TI-82 or TI-83 Plus or TI-84 Plus (To be used in Math and Science) Math teachers suggest the purchase of a TI-84 Plus as it is efficient in its graphing capabilities and compatible with the teacher overhead devices. The Graphing Calculator is strongly encouraged for upper level math course and will be used throughout High School. A scientific calculator is adequate for the 9th grade class.
- Set of markers (Optional)
- Set of highlighters (Optional)
- Package Colored Pencils (Optional)

Other items may be required for elective classes.

Students will **not** be issued laptop computers in the high school. Teachers will be using classroom sets of computers. Students need to have a memory stick (pen file, flash drive, etc) on which they can save work done in class to be used the next day in class or at home. A 128 MB memory stick will be big enough to handle the type of work assigned for school.
