



The Wells-Ogunquit CSD School will be holding a student influenza vaccination clinic **on September 18 from 3pm-7pm at the Wells High School Cafeteria.** Students unable to attend the clinic at WHS, may receive a school day vaccination during the week of October 7 (with a signed permission form returned to their school nurse).

Please read the *Vaccine Information Sheets* posted on the District web page <http://www.k12wocsd.net/> and complete the attached Health Screen & Permission Form and bring it to the clinic (we will have hard copies there if you don't have printer access) or return to your School Nurse by Monday September 30 for an October school day vaccine. (Call your school nurse if you need hard copies for the school day vaccine.)

Both the injectable and nasal spray vaccines will be available.

- ✓ **Reminder:** Some children less than 9 years of age may need 2 doses of flu vaccine this year.
- ✓ Please see the Information Sheet for Parents to determine if your child will need 2 doses.
