

COMMITTEE MEMBER AUTHORITY

Because all powers of the School Committee lie in its action as a group, individual School Committee members exercise their authority over District affairs only as they vote to take action at a legal meeting of the School Committee.

In other instances, an individual School Committee member, including the chair, has power when the School Committee, by vote, has legally delegated authority to him/her.
