

POST-SECONDARY ENROLLMENT & CREDIT

A Wells High School student may enroll in a course at any accredited post-secondary degree conferring institution* at no cost to the District, provided the course is one not offered at Wells High School and/or is adjudged by the Wells High School principal to be appropriate for the individual student.

In order to earn credit toward high school graduation by taking such a course, the student must secure prior approval from the Wells High School principal or his/her designee and must successfully complete the course(s).

If a student chooses to use such course(s) for credit toward high school graduation, then on an individual basis Wells High School will work out how much high school credit has been earned based on the number of hours in class and study out of class. Such a course will be weighted and figured in to the individual's G.P.A. (grade point average).

If a student chooses to take such a course while in high school but to use the credit only as post-secondary education credits, enrollment in the course(s) will be noted on the Wells High School transcript but no grade will be recorded or figured into the G.P.A.

If such a course is taken to fulfill a high school requirement, the course must be taken for high school credit and must appear on the student transcript and be figured into the G.P.A.

*These provisions apply to ITV courses, Wells-Ogunquit C.S.D. Adult/Community Education courses and university, college, community college or vocational technical college courses.
