SCHOOL VOLUNTEERS

The Wells-Ogunquit C.S.D. School Committee endorses cooperative efforts between the community and the District. The School Committee recognizes that volunteers make valuable contributions to our students and our schools. In fulfilling the District's Mission Statement, the School Committee supports the utilization of community resources, including volunteers, to compliment and supplement educational programs.

Volunteers provide services to students by supplementing the work of professional and paraprofessional staff. They work under the supervision and at the request of a staff member; they are not substitutes for a classroom teacher. All volunteers are expected to be professional and dependable in their volunteer activities.

Volunteers may be involved in many facets of school operations from mentor/tutor relationships to clerical tasks. School personnel who are responsible for tasks or projects that will make use of volunteers will identify tasks and time schedules for such activities and make provisions for adequate supervision.
