

## GRADUATION EXERCISES

Diplomas will be awarded only to those students who successfully meet the graduation criteria established by the Wells-Ogunquit C.S.D. Students who successfully meet the graduation requirements shall participate in graduation exercises. Students who do not meet graduation requirements will not be permitted to participate in any ceremonies that require the wearing of a cap and gown (e.g., graduation, convocation).

Foreign exchange students to Wells High School who are taking a senior year curriculum and who successfully pass all required courses may participate in the Wells High School graduation ceremony to complete their experience as a student in the United States.

Foreign exchange students to Wells High School who participate in graduation ceremonies will be presented with a Certificate of Appreciation within the diploma jacket but will not be awarded a high school diploma.

In order to be designated valedictorian or salutatorian of the graduating class, a student must have attended Wells High School for at least two years.
